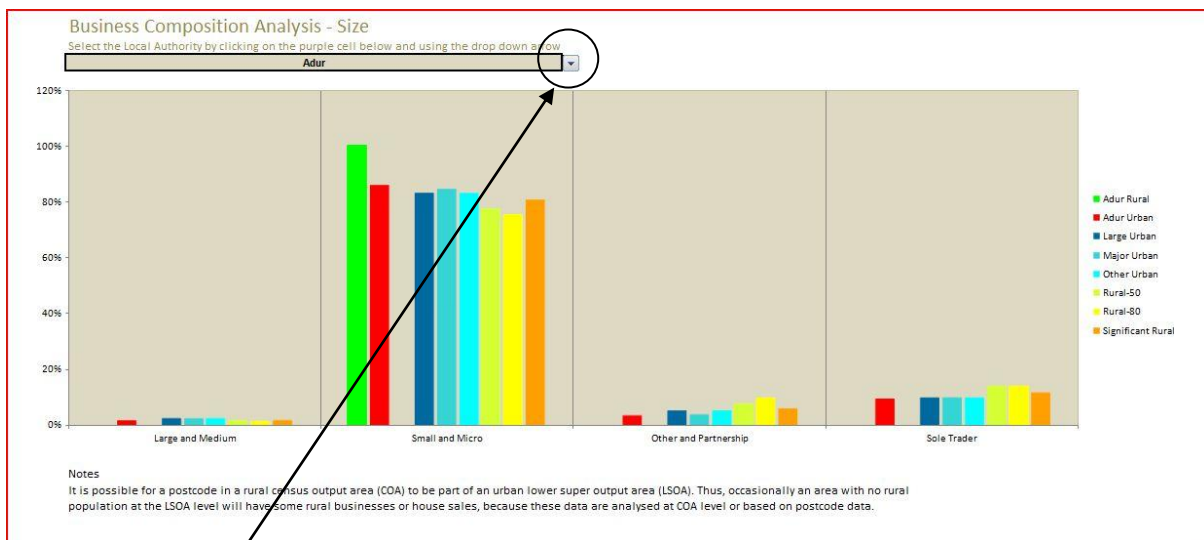


A simple guide to RSN online Spreadsheets – Analysis of business size

The analysis of business size spreadsheet provides a breakdown for each authority the percentage composition of its business sizes, split between rural and urban, based on Output Areas. It also provides a comparison of the same size classifications for businesses within large urban, major urban, other urban, rural-50, rural-80, and significantly rural areas.

The data was collected for the year April 2011 to March 2012 (kindly supplied by DEFRA).

To select the authority of interest, please follow these instructions:



On selecting the tan cell containing an authority name, a grey box with a blue arrow head appears. Clicking on the grey square will provide the list of authorities to select from. The full list can be seen by using the scroll bar to the side of the list.

Click on the option required for the analysis, and its data will be presented.
