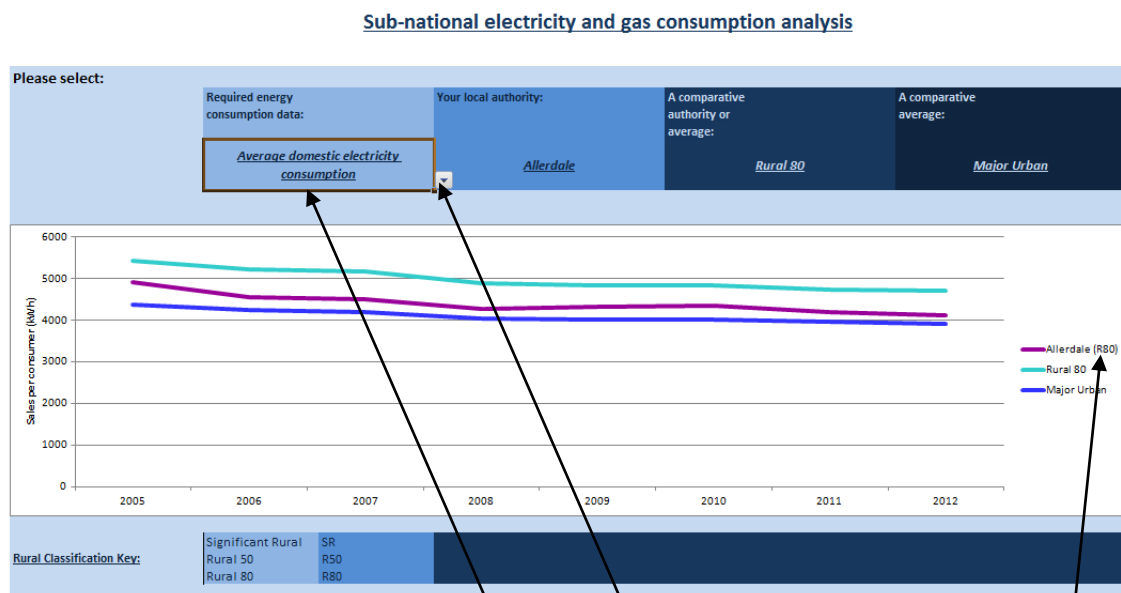


A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Sub-national electricity and gas consumption analysis

The attached spreadsheet presents information on electricity and gas consumption at the local authority level for the period spanning 2005 to 2012 (2012 being provisional data). The data comes from the Department of Energy & Climate Change.

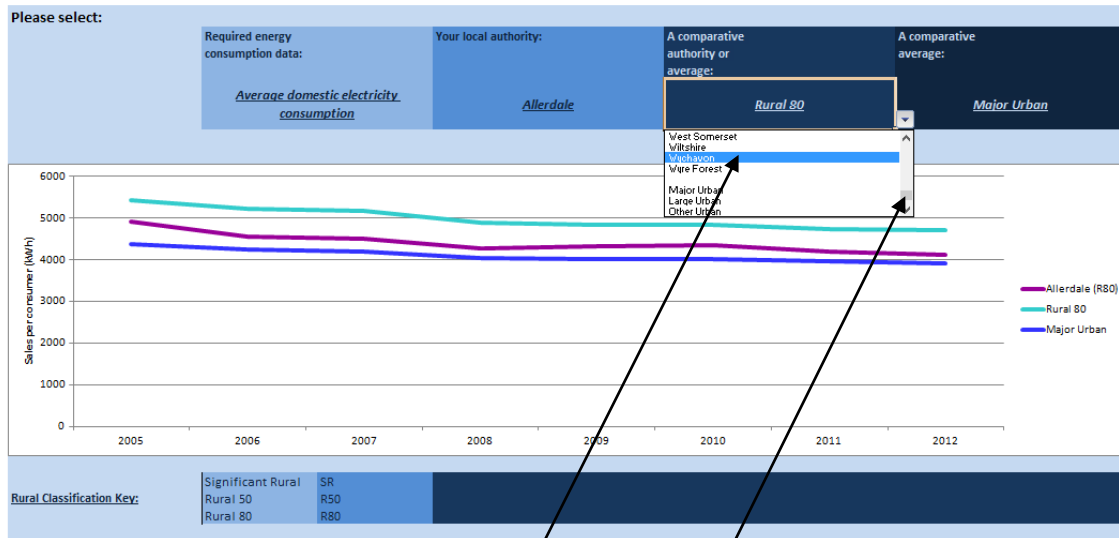
The spreadsheet allows the user to select whether the analysis presents data for electricity or gas consumption, domestic or industrial use. The spreadsheet also allows the user to choose any RSN member authority, a comparative authority or rural/urban average, and a rural/urban average. To select any one of these options, please follow the instructions below:



Clicking on any of the underlined options will bring up a grey square containing a blue triangular arrow head to the right of the option.

The rural classification of the chosen local authority is shown here.

Clicking on the grey square to the right of the cell produces the full list of options. A scroll bar to the right of the options reveals the full list.
