

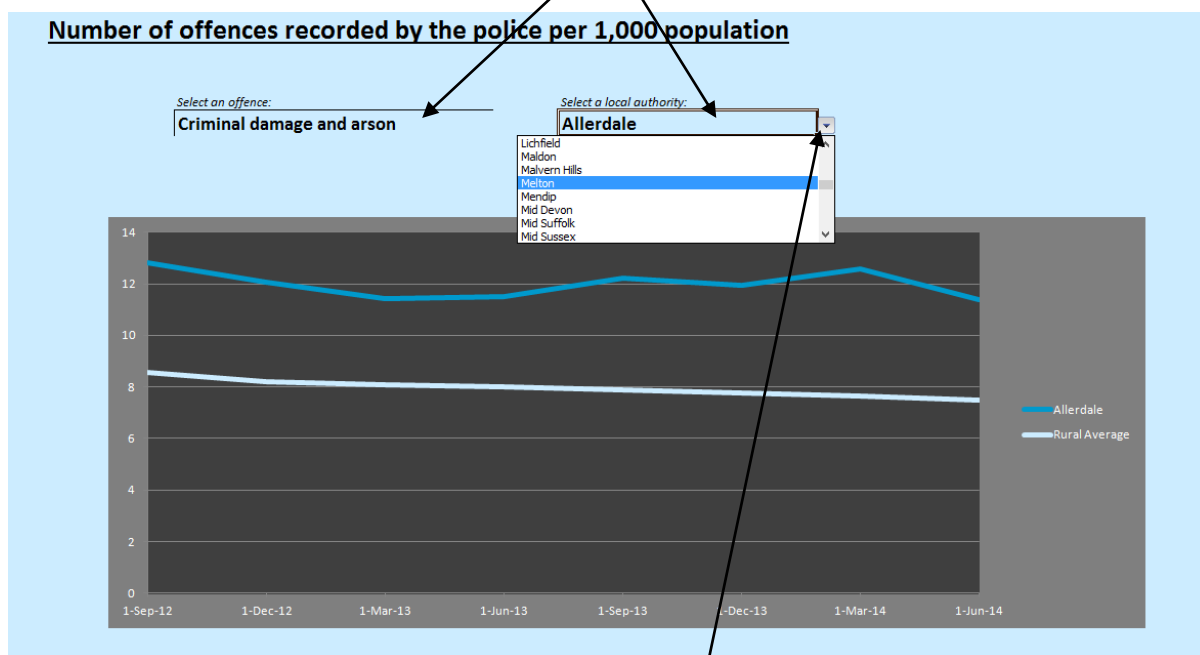
A Guide to RSN Online Spreadsheets - Recorded Crime

Police forces in England and Wales are required to send police recorded crime data to the Home Office. The following analysis takes this data, and presents it at the local authority level (zero values are shown if the data is not available at LA level). The data is shown for a rolling 12 months to each quarter basis.

For comparison purposes, 2013 mid-year population figures have been used to present the information on a per 1,000 head basis.

To use the RSN analysis of Recorded Crime taken from the Office for National Statistics, please follow these simple steps.

Two option boxes allow the user to select the local authority of interest and the offence for which information is required.



Using the mouse to select either of the option cells reveals a grey square with a blue triangle to the right of the option. Clicking on the grey square then reveals the full list of options to select from.
