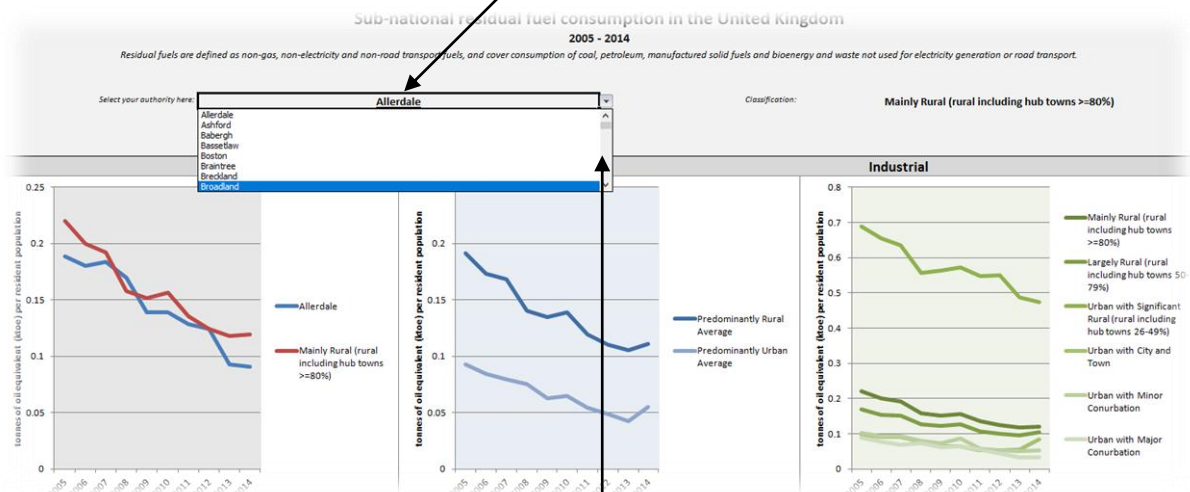


A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Sub-national residual fuel consumption in the United Kingdom

Residual fuels are defined as non-gas, non-electricity and non-road transport fuels, and cover consumption of coal, petroleum, manufactured solid fuels and bioenergy and waste not used for electricity generation or road transport. The analysis presents the different residual fuel consumption characteristics of rural and urban local authority populations, and the changing fuel consumption picture over the last ten years. To select the authority of interest, please follow these steps:

Using the mouse, left click on the cell containing an authority name.



Clicking this time on the grey square with a blue triangle to present the drop down list of options, use the scroll bar to find the authority of interest before selecting that authority.
