

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – Analysis of Active People Survey 6

The sixth year of the survey, Active People Survey 6, started in mid October 2011 and ran continuously for 12 months until the mid October 2012.

The full year results were published on 6 December 2012.

The RSN analysis of the results shows the adult participation in 30 minute, moderate intensity sport, over the 6 year programme of the Active People Survey. Results are graphed for either a selected authority, or for an average of all authority areas apportioned to the following urban/rural classifications:

Rural-80

Rural-50

Significant Rural

Large Urban

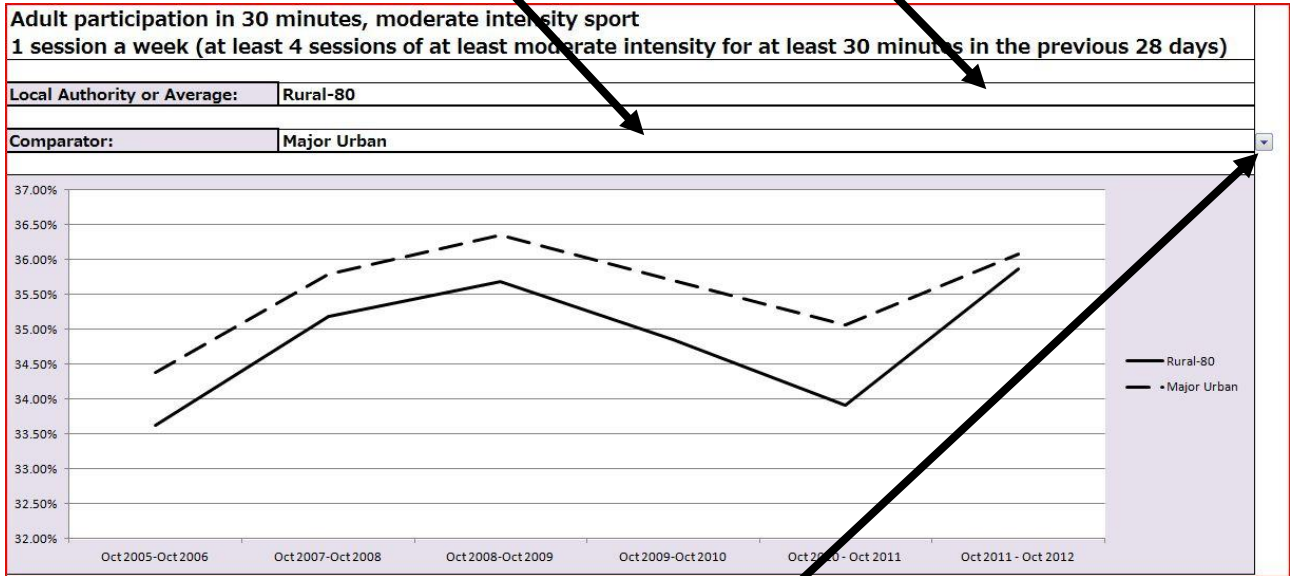
Other Urban

Major Urban

A comparative authority or average can also be selected and is plotted on the same axis.

To make your selection from either list, please follow these instructions:

Select either of these cells. Once the cell is selected, a grey square with a blue triangle will appear to the right of the cell.



Clicking on the grey square will provide the list of options available to select from. The full list of options can be seen by using the scroll bar to the side of the list. Use the mouse pointer to select the option of interest.
