

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – Parking operations revenue 2009–13

The analysis of parking operations revenue uses data published by the RAC Foundation, collected from council returns to DCLG.

The spreadsheet allows the user to first of all select whether they are interested in either county or district or unitary authority data. The user is then able to select an authority of interest.

The next selection made by the user provides comparative data of a neighbouring lower tier authority of the same county as the initial pick.

The final selection that can be made is for any member district or unitary authority, to plot its' data against the rural/urban averages.

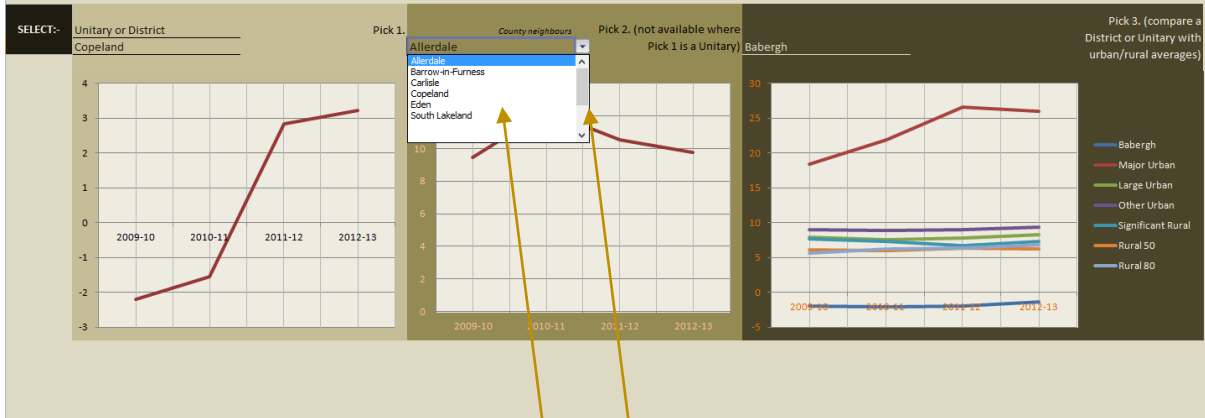
The graphs show the revenue generated per head of population for the selected authorities.



Clicking on any of the underlined options will bring up a grey square containing a blue triangular arrow head to the right of the option.

Clicking on the grey square to the right of the cell produces the full list of options. A scroll bar to the right of the options reveals the full list.
