

## A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - National Travel Survey

The analysis of the National Travel Survey 2015 presents the difference in travel habits between rural and urban areas. It has two worksheets. The first worksheet is the Index sheet, where it is possible to click on the item of interest to see the corresponding graph. The second sheet is the front sheet where all the graphs are presented. This guide has been created to aid you to quickly and easily access relevant data.

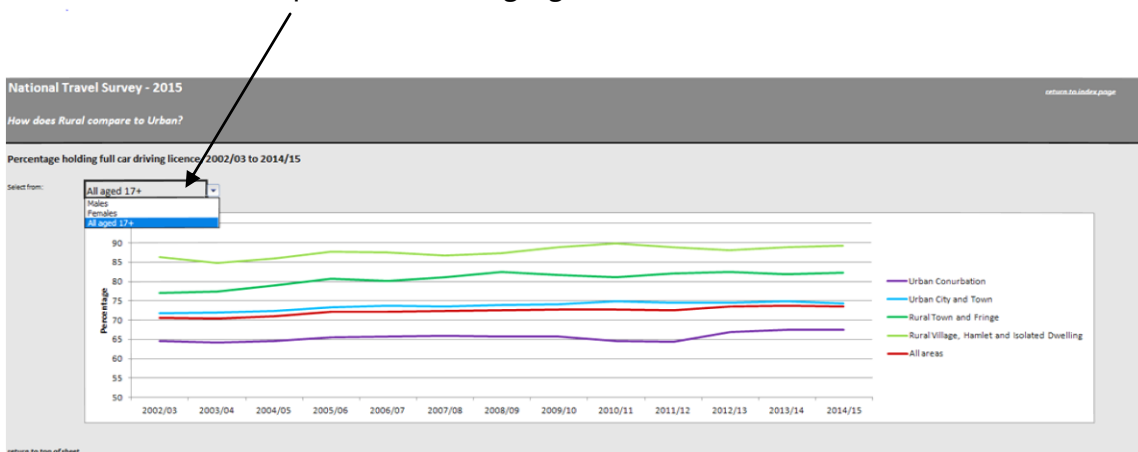
